#### **NATIONAL MEET PERSPECTIVE**

Post enactment of the RTI Act, its implementation in India is still a matter of concern. We are moving toward a system which is becoming more & more open and transparent, thereby, bringing increased accountability of Public Authorities across the country. Presently, there are about 255 CPSEs which are under the ambit of RTI Act 2005. Effective implementation of RTI Act demands frequent interaction and sharing of experiences in CPSEs as most of them are involved in commercial activities. Hence, this National Meet will help in maintaining consistency in replies, better understanding of the act, as well as building awareness about latest modification/ amendments, etc. During this program focus shall be more on commercial information, personal information disclosures & emerging trends in RTI Act. SCOPE shall also address the issues and concerns of CPSEs emerged during the National Meet as an important part of its advocacy role, thus influencing the policy makers in relevant Ministries of the Government of India and the Central Information Commission.

With a view to provide platform to CPSEs to deliberate on the challenges being faced in the management & implementation of RTI Act, SCOPE proposes to organize a "NATIONAL MEET" of Chief Executives/ Directors / **Executive Directors/ CPIOs/ PIOs/ APIOs/ Nodal Officers** & Executives on RTI Act from 14th to 16th September, 2022, at Hotel The Zen, Leh, Ladakh.

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

to enable Chief Executives/ Directors / Executive Directors/ CPIOs/ PIOs/ APIOs/ Nodal Officers & Executives of CPSEs to gain better appreciation of the RTI Act and the issues involved for its effectiveness & true RTI implementation in their respective organizations. The participants will get the opportunity to deliberate on the latest developments / trends and get themselves updated in the area of RTI

The objective of the National Meet is Act. Main focus shall be on disclosures of the commercial information, personal & fiduciary information latest developments in the RTI Act, challenges in Transparency Audit and update their knowledge on the subject.
