

The number of PSUs in the country increased from 234 in 2014 to 254 today, and most of them are giving record returns drawing the attention of investors. The PSU Index in the country has witnessed a two-fold rise within the last year. In the last 10 years, PSU's net profit saw an increase from Rs. 1.25 lakh crore between 2004 and 2014 to Rs. 2.50 lakh crore, and the net value of PSUs increased from Rs. 9.5 lakh crore to Rs. 17 lakh crore.

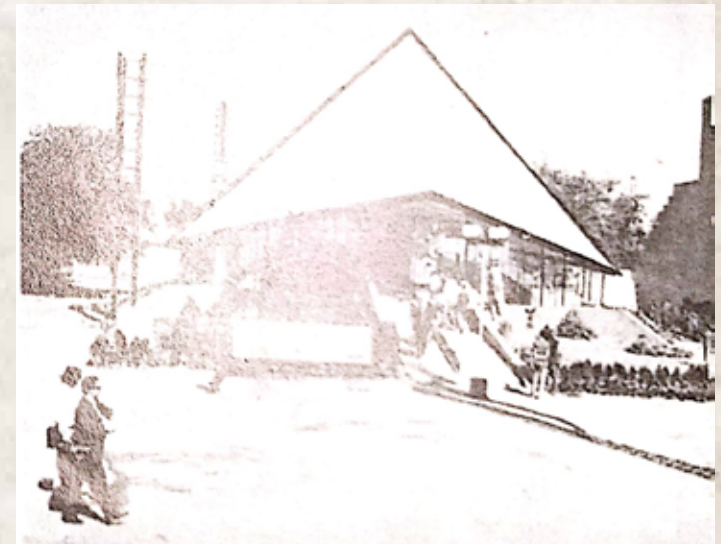
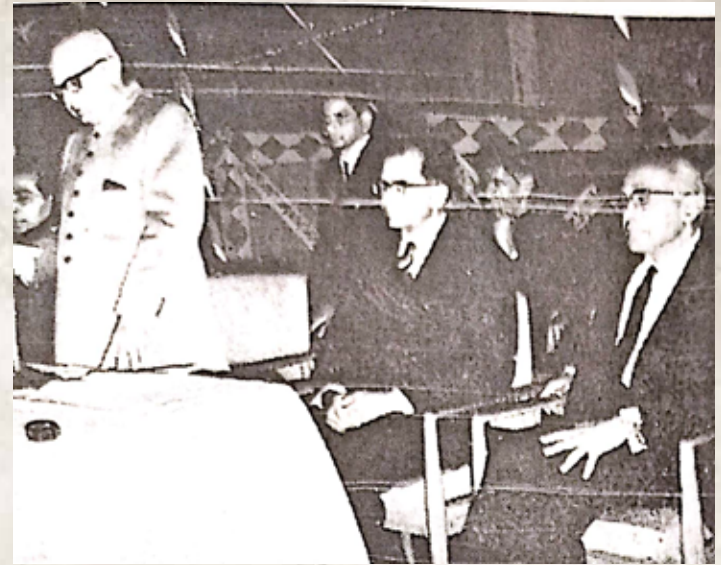

GENESIS OF AN IDEA AND BIRTH OF AN INSTITUTION

SCOPE took roots in a modest way. The idea of an organization of Public Enterprises to act as their spokesman and to interact with the owner i.e. the government was taking shape in the minds of a few dynamic chief executives way back in 1969. As public enterprises belong to people of India, a need was felt for setting up a representative organization of public sector enterprises to have better understanding of the role played by them in the national economy. And thus began the story of birth of an organization

With the basic objective of promoting “better understanding among the public about the individual and collective contribution of public sector”, a registered society called “NEW HORIZON”-a public enterprise information centre- was set up in





NEW DELHI on September 29, 1970.



Gradually the amorphous concepts began to take shape, and subsequently, NEW HORIZON was rechristened as STANDING CONFERENCE OF PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SCOPE).



The objectives were widened and SCOPE assumed the role and contours of an apex body of Central Public Sector Enterprises on April 10, 1973. It was given formal recognition by the Government of India on November 8, 1976 by a decision of Union Cabinet.



Over its eventful journey of 50 years, SCOPE has achieved many milestones as it embraced a constructive role to fortify the role of Public Sector Enterprises (PSEs) as nation builders.

Today, given the changing social and economic dynamics, SCOPE has evolved itself into an effective organization by reinventing, repositioning and rebooting itself through a series of novel initiatives which expand beyond learning and development to effective policy advocacy, research & studies and brand building to enable PSEs to carve a niche for themselves in the global map.

Standing Conference of Public Enterprises (SCOPE), an apex body of Public Sector Enterprises (PSEs) was formed in 1973, aiming to promote competitiveness and excellence amongst its members by enhancing their efficiencies and operational capacities with the help of conducive policies and strategies.

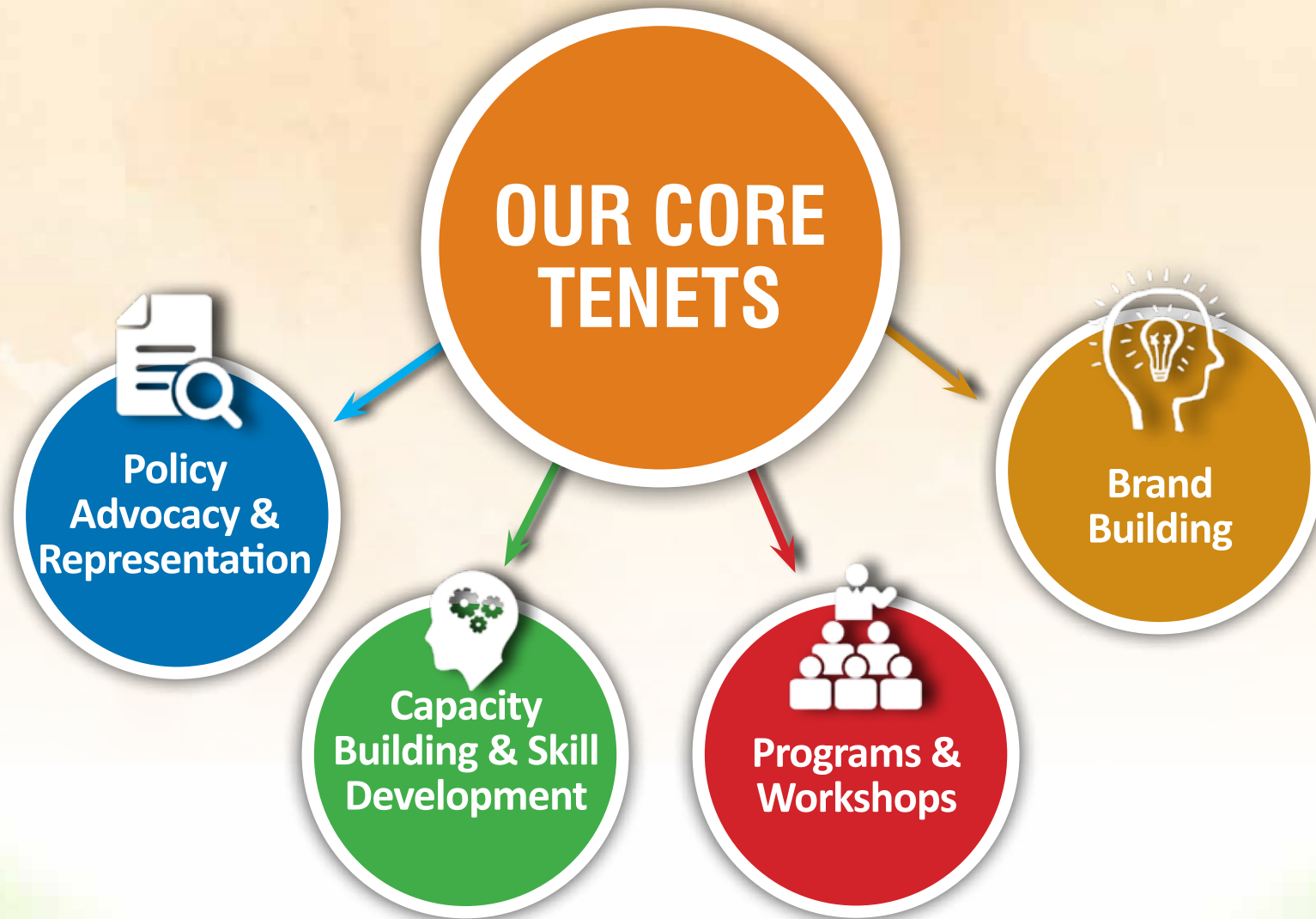
A HISTORIC DAY MARKING THE ANNUAL CALENDER OF ALL PSEs
