1. Online e- tenders are invited by GGM (Tech. & HR), SCOPE on behalf of Constituents of SCOPE Minar, Laxmi Nagar, Delhi- 110092 for the following work up to 25.11.2025 at (3:00 P.M.) and will be opened on the same day at 3:30 P.M.:-

- 1.1 Name of the work :** Redevelopment of 2 nos. Borewells at Scope Minar, Laxmi Nagar, Delhi-110092.
- 1.2 Estimated Cost :** Rs. 25,93,282/- plus GST @18%
- 1.3 Earnest Money :** Rs. 61,500/-
- 1.4 Tender Processing Fee :** Rs. 2,295/-
- 1.5 Time for completion :** **4 months** from the date of issuance of LOI.

- 2. Bidders have to download the bid documents from the e-procurement portal i.e <https://scope.ewizard.in> after registering themselves on portal and submit e-bids after payment of Bid processing Fee & Bid documents fee before last date & time of downloading E-Bid online (For tendering support:-9355030607, 9355030630). Bidder can also view the E-NIT, SCOPE of work on www.scopeonline.in.**
- 3. Bids shall be submitted through e-bidding mode only. No other mode of Bid submission shall be accepted.**
- 4. Tender document shall be accepted only from reputed, specialized Contractors working with CPWD/PWD/MES/Railway/PSUs/ Autonomous Bodies/ Govt. approved Bodies & Societies/ SCOPE who fulfill following pre-qualification criteria & showing their original documents in this regard:**
- 4.1 Proof of experience of having successfully completed Similar works during the last 5 years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which applications are invited:**



Three similar completed works, each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of estimated cost put to tender in the last five years.

OR

Two similar completed works, each costing not less than the amount equal to 60% of the estimated cost put to tender in the last five years.

OR

One similar completed work of aggregate cost not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost put to tender in the last five years.

Similar works means Rain water harvesting/ Tube wells works.

- 4.2 The Tenderer must be registered under ESI, PF, GST & income tax act and should have PAN number. The copies of registration papers along with details need to be furnished. Latest ESI & PF deposit with challan authority is also needed.
- 4.3 Average annual financial turn over should be at least 100% of the estimated cost during the immediate last 03 consecutive financial year. Balance sheet for previous last three years along with I.T.R to be submitted.

5.0 The bidder shall furnish an affidavit affirming that the firm/agency has neither been blacklisted and debarred and nor their services have been banned or suspended due to any reason including corrupt and fraudulent practices in the past by any Govt. department/ Institutions/Local bodies/Municipalities/ Public sector Undertaking/ Autonomous bodies etc. and there is no any vigilance/ CBI case pending against the firm/agency.

- 5.1 All the above certificate/documents shall be submitted by the firm duly signed & self-attested subject to verification with original documents.
- 5.2 The tender cost (Form fee), Earnest Money Deposit (EMD), and tender processing fee (TPF) must be paid by the bidder through online payment mode only, as provided on the e-tendering portal, i.e. <https://scope.ewizard.in>. In case the bidder fails to technically qualify as per eligibility criteria of the tender or is not the lowest (L1) bidder, the EMD amount will be refunded to the bidder's account details as provided on the bidder enrollment registration page of SCOPE e-tendering portal: <https://scope.ewizard.in>.

6.0 The tender shall be submitted through only portal i.e., <https://scope.ewizard.in>.

7. Tenders are invited to submit their offers strictly based on the layout, design parameters, Specific requirements, terms & conditions and specifications and instruction to bidder given in the tender document.
8. The agencies are strictly advised to visit the site before quoting their rates in the tender. An undertaking of visit shall be submitted to SCOPE duly signed in between contractor & concern engineer of SCOPE. The undertaking must ne uploaded on the site of e-wizard along with the bids, failing which tender will not be considered/rejected for opening of price bid.
9. SCOPE reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons.

SCOPE OF WORK

The Scope of work shall, inter alia, include the following:

1. To execute to the work as per items mentioned in the schedule of only as per latest CPWD DSR & other relevant specification and market rates.
2. The work is to be executed in an occupied building where PSU offices are functioning. Hence, work shall be done in a proper manner with minimum disturbance to the working environment of the building. The rate to be quoted for each item & for all leads, lifts at the above-mentioned places in SCOPE Minar. Nothing extra shall be payable.
3. The contractor should carry out the work with utmost care to as to not disturb/dispute/damage the interiors done by various constituent PSUs of the building.
4. The disposal of removal material shall be done in a systematic manner away from the grounds of SCOPE Minar and it shall not be allowed to accumulate.
5. Dismantled portions become most vulnerable places till the "Redevelopment of 2 nos. Borewells at Scope Minar, Laxmi Nagar, Delhi- 110092" work is carried out.
6. Supply & application of all the consumables complete in all respect.
7. Proper site clearance after completion of work and during the progress of work as per instructions of Engineer-in-Charge.
8. Dismantled surplus material should be disposed off from the site to stores of SCOPE as per directions of Engineer-In-Charge.
9. After completion of work and during progress of work, proper site clearance should be done as per the directions of Engineer-In-Charge.
10. Supply & fixing of all the materials required to carry out the work including all consumables are also in the scope of work of contractor. Nothing shall be paid extra on this account.
11. As this work is to be carried out in locations where offices of the constituents of SCOPE Minar are functioning, contractor has to work in such manner that constituents face minimum disturbance. For this purpose, contractor may have to work in late hours or after office hours or on holidays including Sundays etc.
12. The work shall be carried out in such a way that no damage to the property of SCOPE/Building occurred and in case of any damage to the same contractor is liable to replace/provide the same.
